

CHILD CARE ASSISTANT Certificate Program



Yorkdale's Child Care Assistant Program enables student to gain knowledge and practical skills through in-school studies and a Co-operative Education experience in a licensed day care facility. Learn about child developmental stages from birth to 6 years old, the Day Care Nursery Act, and what is necessary to set up a licensed childcare centre in Ontario. This course is taught by highly qualified instructors.



In this 18 week Program students can:

- Earn 6 credits towards your Secondary School Diploma
- Earn a Child Care Assistant Certificate
- Gain experience through a placement in a licenced Day Care Centre

Part 2

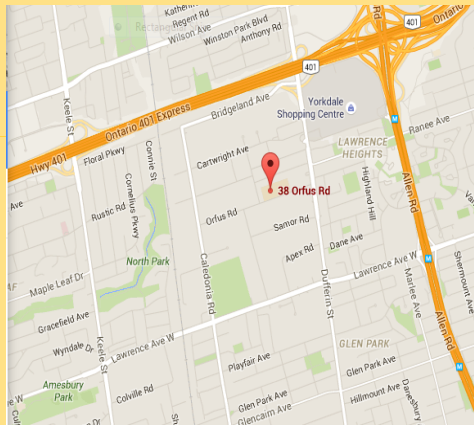
Out of School (9 weeks- 270hours)

Program Registration Information

Registration:

September and February

Classes: (there are no classes in July and August)

- September– January
- February—June

To register you must:

- Be 21 years of age or have an OSSD
- Have an English 11C or achieve a eligible grade in the Yorkdale English assessment test
- Pass an interview with a Yorkdale Staff member

Successful applicants must be able to show proof of the following:

(not required until accepted into the program)

- Updated immunizations, Hepatitis B, flu shot, 2 step TB test
- Clear Vulnerable Sector Police Search

OSAP is not Available .

Financial assistance may be available through OW, WSIB, ODSP, Employment Ontario, Toronto Employment and Social Services
